Curriculum at a Glance

Mathematics- Students will begin to explore the relationship between fractions and division. They will represent fractions with concrete models and begin to add/subtract fractions with unlike denominators.

Social Studies- The students will take a quiz on the early influences upon U.S. government (Athens, Iroquois, and the Roman Republic). *(Ms. Siudak's class) Monday, February 9 & (Ms. Downing's class) Wednesday, February 11* They will also begin to study the U.S. government.

Writing- Students begin to study fantasy stories. They will use this knowledge (theme, conflict, etc.) to begin drafting their own fantasy stories. They will continue to listen to *The Phantom Tollbooth* by Norton Juster.
